Connecticut Birth to Three System

For children birth-36 months of age with developmental delays or disabilities.

- Free Developmental Evaluation
- Service Coordination
- Individualized Family Service Plan (IFSP)
- Services from Early Childhood Therapists and Teachers as identified in the IFSP
- Focus on assisting families through natural routines and activities

Help Me Grow

For children birth through age 8 considered 'at-risk' for developmental or behavioral problems

- Connects families to community based resources
- Provides Ages and Stages child monitoring program
- Trains child health providers in developmental screening
- Facilitates regional community networking

Early Childhood Special Education

For children ages 3 through 5 who are found eligible for special education services

- Evaluation
- Services to eligible children:
 - Individualized Education Program (IEP)
 - Special education and related services

Children and Youth with Special Health Care Needs

For children and youth birth to age 21 with chronic physical, developmental, behavioral, or emotional conditions who require more health and related services than other children the same age.

- Service Needs Assessment
- Care Coordination
- Benefits Coordination
- Family/Caregiver Support
- Respite Planning
- Links to medical home initiative
- Referrals to community based resources
- Transition Planning
